FRESHMEN AND TRANSFER ADMISSIONS

FRESHMEN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Graduation from high school or receipt of a General Education Development (GED) and completion of the 15 unit specific A-G high school courses with a "C" or better.

COLLEGE PREPARATORY REQUIREMENTS (A-G):

(A) History/Social Sciences – 2 YEARS REQUIRED

Two years of history/social science, including one year of world history, culture and geography; and one year of U.S. History or one-half year of U.S. History and one-half year of civics or American government.

(B) English – 4 YEARS REQUIRED

Four years of college-preparatory English. No more than one year of ESL.

(C) Mathematics – 3 YEARS REQUIRED (4 Years Recommended)

Three years of college-preparatory math (Algebra I, Geometry and Algebra II, Trigonometry, Calculus, etc).

(D) Laboratory Science – 2 YEARS REQUIRED

Two years of laboratory science providing fundamental knowledge in at least two of these three foundational subjects: biology, chemistry and physics.

(E) Language Other than English – 2 YEARS REQUIRED

Two years of the same language other than English.

(F) Visual & Performing Arts (VPA) – 1 YEAR REQUIRED

A single yearlong approved arts course from a single Visual Performing Arts discipline: dance, drama/theatre, music or visual art.

(G) College-Preparatory Elective – 1 YEAR REQUIRED

One year in addition to the required in "A-F" courses listed above.

The CSU Eligibility Index (EI) is calculated as follows:

1. (Your GPA*) x 800 + the sum of your SAT Mathematics and Critical Reading Score
2. (Your GPA*) x 200 + (10 x ACT Composite Score)

* 10th – 11th grade "A-G" Coursework

* Please note that neither the ACT nor SAT writing scores are included in the calculation of the CSU Eligibility Index

Admissions Tests:

Take the SAT Reasoning Test or ACT by the end of October, but **NO LATER THAN** December of your senior year. Test scores should be sent directly to the Office of Admissions and Outreach from the testing agencies, the College Board (collegeboard.org) or the ACT (act.org). Cal Poly Pomona's test code is **4082**.
